

Location, Location, Location - Project Homework

There are two projects to complete this half term as part of our Topic that explores the beaches and coastlines around the world

1: Interview an older relative (as old as possible!) about their memories of beach holidays when they were a child.

Try to find out as much as you can about how things were different to today.

You might ask: How long was the holiday? Where did you go? What did you do there? What did you eat and drink? What year was it? What was your favourite part? And anything else you can think of.



2: We have looked at a beach over 100 years ago, and what they are like now, but your project is to imagine what a beach will look like 100 years in the future? How will it be different? What activities or events might you see?

You can present this to the class in any way that you want to. This might be a picture, a 3D model or a written setting description of what could be seen.
