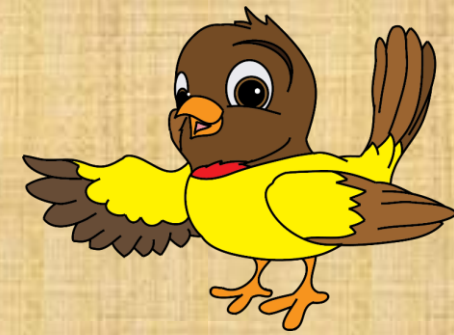

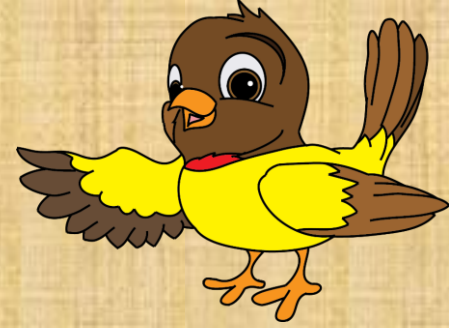

# Robins Class Expectations

- Transition year! First steps away from guided play and learning through play. More formal provision for larger portions of the day which will gradually increase throughout the year.

# Reading



**Important** - underpins and supports learning in all other curriculum areas.

**Phonics** – daily phonics lessons. Children to be grouped for RWI. Year 1 Screening check – further information to come later in the year.

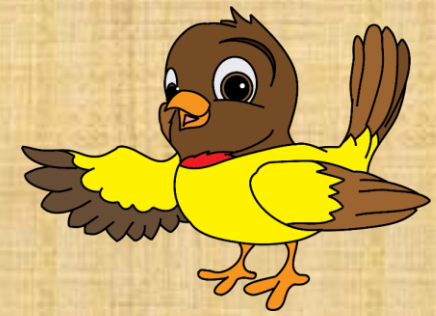
**Common Exception Words** – Important to learn by sight as this will aid fluency in reading. (RED words)

**Reading at home** – very important this year.

Emphasis on reading for meaning and reading for pleasure – please question your child and discuss the story.

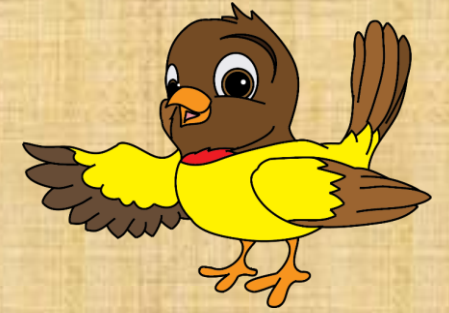
100 Book Challenge - Children have an opportunity to change their book first thing in the morning when they have finished reading it – please remind them to do so. Designed for exposure to different book types and for pleasure. Not expected to read it alone. Please enjoy it together.

# Homework



- **Half Termly Topic Homework** – Includes activities related to English, Maths and our Topic. A copy of the current homework sheet can be found on the website.
- Focus on reading daily – little and often. Please sign reading record.
- Weekly spellings on Spelling Shed. Spelling test on Thursday mornings.

# Drop off and Pick up



- **Mornings** – Please encourage your child to stand in the line on their own. – They are doing fantastic at this!
- **Afternoons** – I will be dismissing the children from the doors at the back of Robins classroom. Please wait outside the little gate to our outdoor area and give me a wave when your child is at the front of the line.
