Dear Parents,

It was such a pleasure to welcome your child into Year 6 on Tuesday and they have all settled beautifully into the routines of Year Six. Mr Franklin and I have been very impressed with their behaviour, attitude towards learning and eagerness to succeed.

I will be teaching the children throughout the week, assisted by Mr Franklin and Mrs Booton who will be teaching the Owls on a Tuesday afternoon as part of my management and leadership time. Delta Challenge will be teaching them on a Monday afternoon, as well as Music and French specialists on Wednesday morning and afternoon respectively. However, if you have any concerns during the school year, please contact me, as your child's class teacher, in the first instance. I do not wish to overload you with information at this stage. To this end, I would like to invite you to a 'Meet the Teacher' meeting on **Monday 8th September at 2.45pm** in the school hall when I shall go through more of the day to day procedures, curriculum and key information for this very important year.

I would also like to invite you a '**Condoover Hall**' meeting on **Monday 15th September at 2.45pm** in the Owls' classroom to discuss the arrangements for our annual residential trip in the Owls' class.

I appreciate that some of you may not be able to attend at this time, so I shall email a summary of the main items covered. If you need to speak to me, please feel free to come and see me, email the school office or pop a note into your child's homework diary (don't forget to remind your child to show it to me!) and I will get back to you as soon as possible. I will start setting homework next week as I didn't want to overload the children on their first week.

I am really looking forward to teaching your child this year and working with you all. I have been very impressed with all of the Owls so far!
