- Design a Poster to advertise one of the Mediterranean countries.
- Write a story or poem about the Mediterranean

- One of the reasons that the Med is a popular place to visit is that it has a wealth of famous artists that have influenced the regions and countries, such as Monet and Michelangelo. Write a biography of one of the artists you have found out about.
