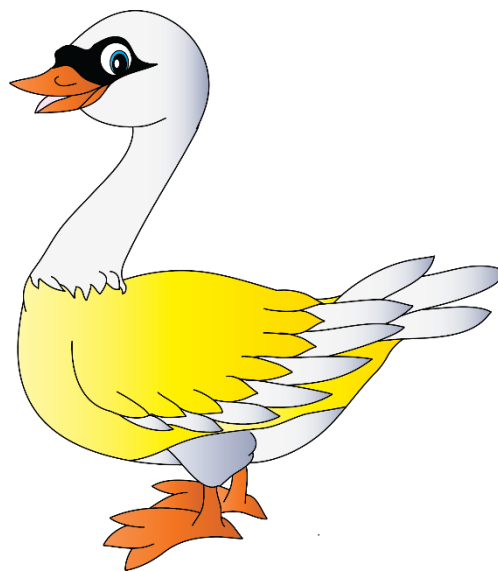

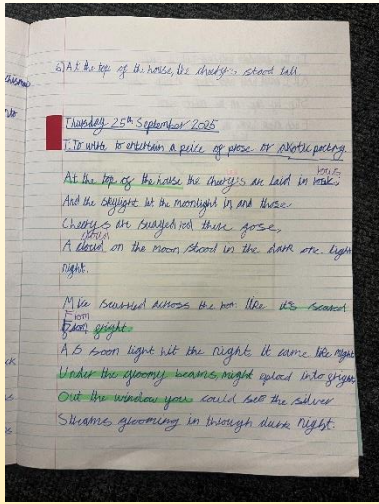

We studied the poem Moonlit Apples and created our own acrostic poetry using this as a stimulus.

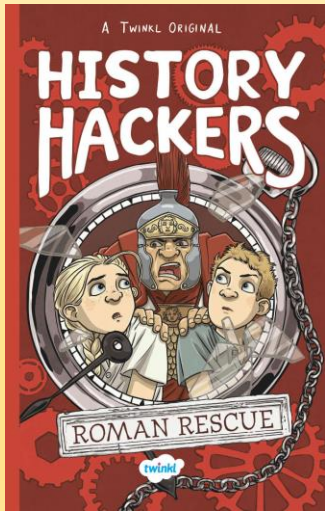


We enjoyed predicting and inferring from the front cover of our class reader. The children wrote some exciting Roman portal stories!

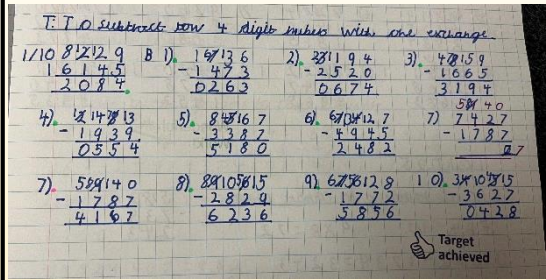

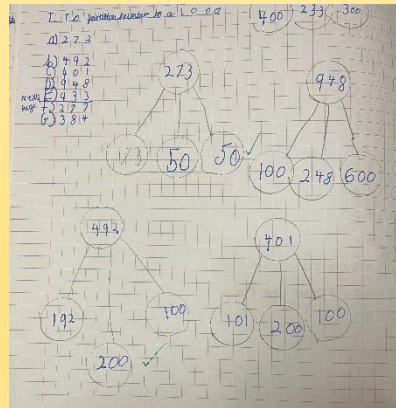
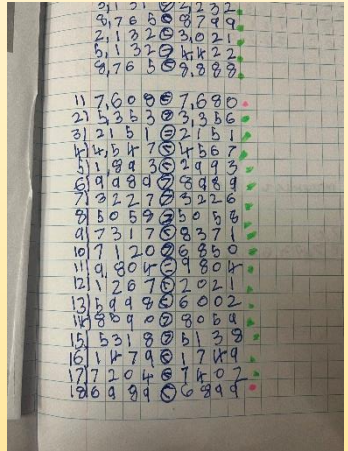

We have been thinking about ones, tens, hundreds and thousands. We used this knowledge when rounding. The children did an amazing job with their column addition and subtraction!

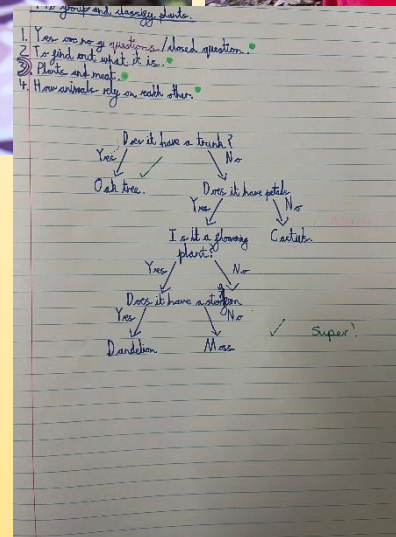
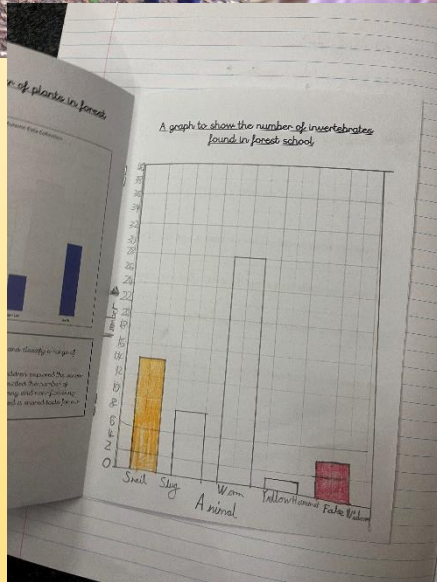

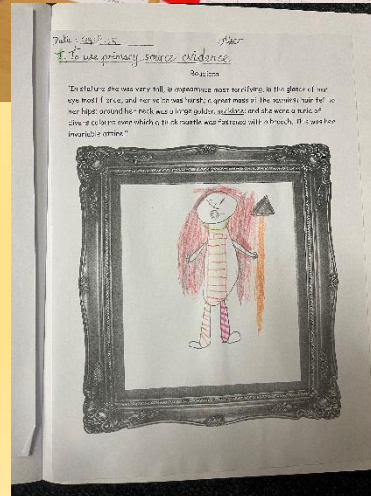
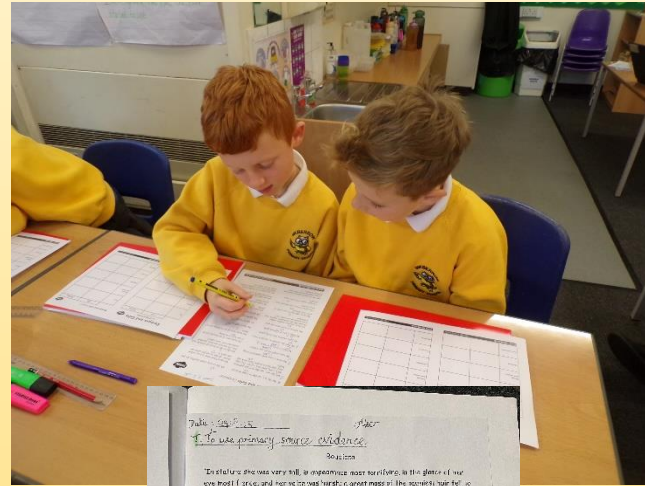
Grouping and classifying living things

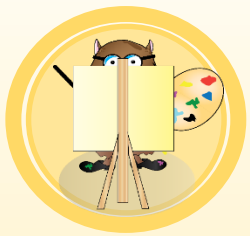
During our topic on classifying living things, we sorted vertebrates into groups and observed invertebrates around the school grounds. We created classification keys, for plants using closed questions.

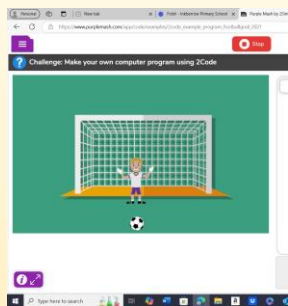

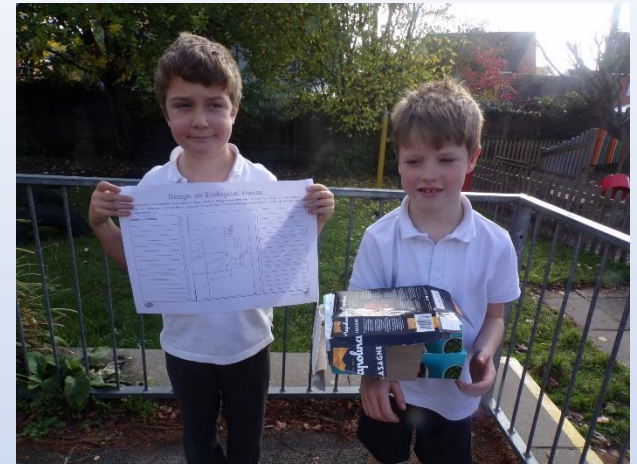


Children planned and performed gymnastics sequences in pairs.

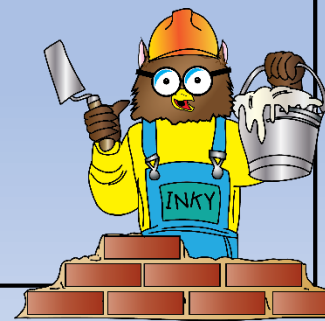


Aspiration Day
