The Times Table Check will take place during the week commencing **Monday 8th June**. Your child will complete this individually in a quiet area using either an iPad or a laptop (their choice). We would also like to invite you to a **Multiplication Times Tables Meeting on Thursday 7th May 2026 at 2:45pm**.

This term, our curriculum will include:

- Writing non-chronological reports
- A narrative unit based on *The Tin Forest*
- A poetry unit inspired by *From a Railway Carriage*

Our class reader this half term will be *How to Train Your Dragon* by Cressida Cowell.

In other subjects:

- **Maths:** Decimals, before moving on to money and time
- **History:** Life in Tudor Times – have a look at the Knowledge Organiser on the Swans' Class page on the website to find out what we'll be covering
- **Science:** Habitats

Spelling homework will be set on Mondays and returned the following Monday. Maths homework will be set on Thursdays and returned the following Thursday. History homework has been handed out today and can also be found on the school website and is due on **Monday 11th May**.
