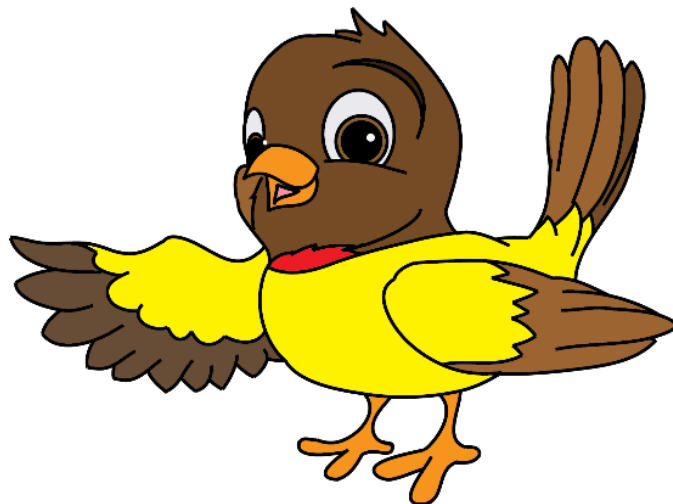

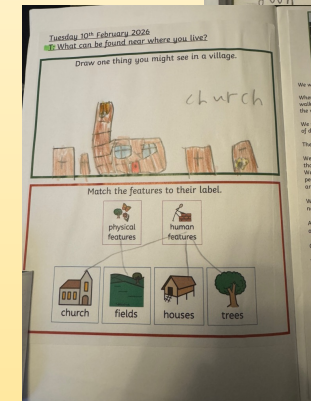
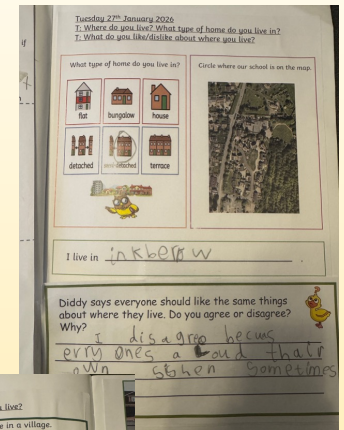


This half term in Maths we completed our on Place Value to 20 and Addition and Subtraction within 20.

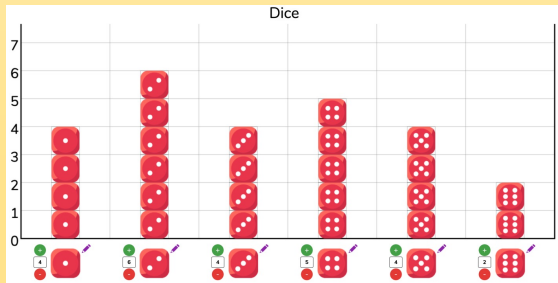
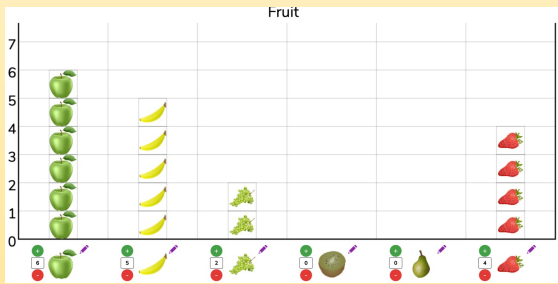

We looked at the features you might find in a village, such as houses, a church and a farm, and we learnt the difference between human features, which are built or used by people, and physical features, which are natural.

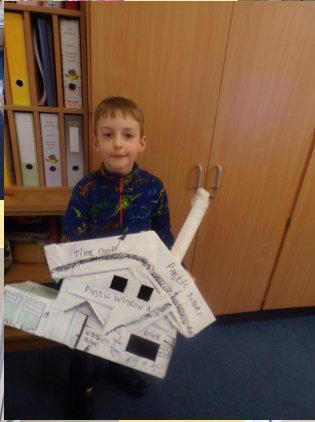


Trips / Visits / Special Weeks
