



## Woodpeckers Topic Homework Extreme Earth Due Monday 14<sup>th</sup> October



**Choose 1 of the options below PLUS a free choice challenge.** Think about how you can present your work creatively to a high standard and ensure your spelling, punctuation and grammar is accurate.

**Fact File:** Research the history of any volcano of your choice. Write a fact file to inform of its location, height, current status, past eruptions and any other interesting facts that you find. Include a map to show its location.

**Poem:** Write a poem about Volcanoes or Earthquakes. It can be any type of poem – acrostic, list, descriptive, shape etc. **Research** the type of poetry before you start writing. Present your work beautifully and include designs/ pictures if appropriate. **Show** that you have edited and improved your work by including drafts with your finished piece.

**Diary Entry:** Write a diary entry from the perspective of a witness to a volcanic eruption or earthquake. Think about how you would be feeling? What did you see, hear, smell etc? Where did the earthquake score on the Richter Scale? What damage did it cause?

**Poster:** Design a poster advising the public how to stay safe during a volcanic eruption or earthquake. Think about key survival tips, use the internet to research guidance given in other countries and present your information creatively with illustrations.

**Free choice challenge:** This is your opportunity to be creative, however here are a few suggestions. You could design and make a meal for a mountain hike, create a board game to play with your friends, an earthquake-proof house with label explaining the different features, a 3D model of a volcano, a word search using our key vocabulary (found on your Knowledge Organisers).
