Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you have enjoyed the sun over the half term!

Our theme for this half term will be 'From Field to Fork'. We will be looking at where food comes from, the journey it takes to reach our plate and how we can keep ourselves healthy by carefully choosing the food we eat. As before, the theme will be cross-curricular, touching on areas of English, Maths, Science, Geography, History and Art.

English

- **Phonics Screening Checks will be completed in week 2 of this half term.**
- Writing Curricular Target – This half term we will continue to develop our English skills, consolidating our use of punctuation as well as promoting imaginative and interesting ideas for writing. We will be enjoying some poetry as well as learning some well-known rhymes.
- Spellings and Spelling Tests - A list of six spellings will continue to be sent home every Thursday for practice.
- Reading – I cannot emphasise how important it is for you to read with your child at home as often as possible. Little and often is more beneficial and less tiring. Please focus on discussing the story with your child (ask simple questions to ensure understanding e.g. why do you think the boy did that?) rather than aiming to finish the book in one evening.

Maths

Our focus for Maths this half term will be Place Value within 100 and Shape, Space and Measure. We will be looking at Time and money as well as position and direction.

We will also continue to have our optional maths homework available on MathShed – I know the feedback from the children has been that they have really enjoyed “playing” something new.
