To build on these experiences, we are excited to share that on Friday 12th June 2026, we will be visiting Attwell Farm Park in Redditch. We will leave school promptly at 9:30am and return in time for the end of the school day as usual.

This trip has been planned to support our topics, 'Animal Kingdom' and 'From Field to Fork'. The children will take part in engaging, school-led workshops where they will learn about what grows on a farm, different animal habitats, and how to care for a variety of animals. It will also be a lovely opportunity to celebrate the children's hard work, particularly following their Phonics Screening.
