Dear Parents/guardians,

It's already been a great start to the year, and the children have already shown me how much they love to learn! I hope they came home with a buzz on Thursday telling you all about the layers of the Earth!

Year 3 is an exciting step into Key Stage 2. Lessons get busier, and the children will be tackling lots of new challenges as they continue to grow in confidence and independence. To make the move as smooth as possible, I've already met with Mr Coy to discuss the children's progress since I had them in Robins.

This year, the children will have reading diaries. These will also be used to record their homework, so please make sure they bring them into school every day. Please continue to listen to your child read daily and jot down a quick note in the diary - it's a great way for us to stay connected about their progress.

Our first **Geography** topic is *Extreme Earth*. We'll be exploring the fascinating world of earthquakes and volcanoes – discovering why they happen and where in the world they can be found. Attached with this letter, you will also find our topic homework and you'll also find our Knowledge Organiser on the school website. If your child has any books or items linked to this topic, it would be wonderful for them to bring them in to share. It's worth noting a slight difference to homework in KS1. In KS2, children will have homework weekly. This will work on a two-weekly rota, alternating between Spellings and Maths.

In **Maths** we will be exploring numbers to 1000, whilst in **Science** we will be digging deeper into skeletons, looking at Animals (including Humans).

Please find below our Autumn Timetable. Should this change, I will let you know. To give you more details about daily routines, homework and life in Key Stage 2, I'd like to invite you to a short meeting in the Hall on **Friday 18th September at 14:45**.
